TO MAKE FURTHER PROVISION FOR THE TWELVE MONTHS ENDED ON THE THIRTY-FIRST DAY OF DECEMBER, 1927. A.D. 1928.

WHEREAS it is necessary to make additional provision for the service for the twelve months ended on the thirty-first day of December, 1927.

BE it therefore enacted:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation Law, 1928. Short title.

2. There shall be issued and applied to the service of the twelve months ended the thirty-first day of December, 1927, an additional sum not exceeding the sum of eight thousand five hundred and thirty-six pounds for defraying the charges of the Government of Cyprus for such period. The said amount shall be appropriated as follows:— Appropriation of £8,536 for twelve months ended 31st December, 1927.

3. It shall be lawful for the Governor to cause to be issued and paid for the purposes aforesaid any sum not exceeding in the whole the sums in that behalf hereinbefore specified. The Governor may authorize payment of the same
