BE it enacted :—

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Antiquities (Amendment) Law, 1928, and shall be read as one with the Antiquities Law, 1905, (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Law), and the Antiquities (Amendment) Law, 1927, and the Principal Law and the said Law and this Law may together be cited as the Antiquities Laws, 1905 to 1908.

2. The Principal Law, section 28, is hereby amended by the deletion in line 10 of the words "Chief Cadi" and the substitution therefor of the words "Turkish Delegate of Evcaf."

3. The Principal Law, section 39, is hereby amended by the deletion in line 5 of the words "Chief Cadi of Cyprus" and the substitution therefor of the words "Turkish Delegate of Evcaf."

A.D. 1928 TO AMEND THE LAW RELATING TO CO-OPERATIVE
CREDIT SOCIETIES.

BE it enacted :—

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Co-operative Credit Societies (Amendment) Law, 1928, and shall be read as one with the Co-operative Credit Societies Law, 1914, (hereinafter referred to as the Principal Law), and the Co-operative Credit Societies (Amendment) Law, 1925, and the Co-operative Credit Societies (Amendment) Law, 1926, and the said Laws and this Law may together be cited as the Co-operative Credit Societies Laws, 1914 to 1928.

2. The Principal Law, section 19, is hereby repealed and in place thereof the following section shall have effect:—

Repeal of Law 13 of 1914, sec. 19, and substitution of new section.

19. (1) The Registrar shall examine or cause to be examined by some person authorized by him by general or special order in writing in this behalf the accounts of every registered Society once at least in every year.

Examination and inspection.

(2) The examination under sub-section (1) shall include an examination of overdue debts, if any, and a valuation of the assets and liabilities of the Society.

(3) The Registrar or any person authorized by general or special order in writing in this behalf by the Registrar shall at all times have access to all the books, accounts, papers, cash and securities of a Society, and every officer of the Society shall furnish such information in regard to the transactions and working of the Society as the person making such inspection may require.

(4) Subject to the general directions and instructions of the Registrar, the Commissioner of the District in which the Society is carrying on business shall be deemed to be a person authorized within the meaning of the preceding sub-section.

3. The Co-operative Credit Societies (Amendment) Law, 1926, section 2, is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following proviso:—

Provided further that the Registrar may before granting the approval in writing as aforesaid require the Society to forward to him a copy of a resolution and of the minutes relating to it of a general meeting of the Society approving of such sales or purchases as the case may be.
