TO AMEND THE LAW RELATING TO WEIGHTS  
AND MEASURES.

BE it enacted :—

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Weights and Measures Law, 1930, and shall be read as one with the Weights and Measures Law, 1890, (hereinafter referred to as the principal Law), and the principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Weights and Measures Laws, 1890 and 1930.

2. The principal Law, section 11, is hereby amended by the deletion of the words "The use" (line 1) to "such sale" (line 5) inclusive and the substitution therefor of the following words,

"The use of any other weight or measure than those defined by this Law shall be unlawful; and any person who sells by any denomination of weight or measure other than one of the weights or measures defined by this Law or some multiple or part thereof, or who has in his possession for use for trade any weight or measure or some multiple or part thereof of such other denomination shall be liable to a fine not exceeding one pound for every such sale or possession".

3. The principal Law, section 14, is hereby amended by the insertion after the words "who uses" (line 1) of the words "or has in his possession for use".

5. The principal Law, section 19, is hereby amended by the insertion after the words "who uses" (line 4) of the words "or has in his possession for use".

6. The principal Law, section 31, is hereby amended by the insertion after the words "person for trade" (line 4) of the words "or in the possession of any person for use for trade".
