

4. The registrar upon registering such trade union shall issue a certificate of registration, which certificate, unless proved to have been withdrawn or cancelled, shall be conclusive evidence that the regulations of this Law with respect to registration have been complied with.

BE it enacted:—

Short title:

1. This Law may be cited as the Cyprus (Customs, Excise and Revenue) Order in Council, 1931, Amendment Law, 1932, and shall be read as one with the Cyprus (Customs, Excise and Revenue) Order in Council, 1931, (hereinafter referred to as the Order).

Amendment
of First
Schedule
to the Order.

2. The First Schedule to the Order is hereby amended as follows:—

(a) The expression

“Petrol and benzine .. 3s. 4½cp. for every 4 gallons or part thereof.”

shall be substituted for the expression

“Petrol and benzine .. 2s. for every 4 gallons or part thereof.”

(b) The expression

“Sugar and candy sugar 3cp. the oke.”

shall be substituted for the expression

“Sugar and candy sugar 2cp. the oke.”.

(c) The expression

“Wheat 6cp. the cwt.”

shall be substituted for the expression

“Wheat 1s. 6cp. the cwt.”.

3. This Law shall come into operation upon its publication in the *Cyprus Gazette*.

TO PROVIDE FOR THE EXERCISE OF CERTAIN POWERS OR RIGHTS AND THE PERFORMANCE OF CERTAIN DUTIES. A.D. 1932. 3 of 1932.

BE it enacted:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Additional Powers, Rights and Duties Law, 1932. Short title.

2. Wherever by any Law in force in the Colony of Cyprus for the time being any power or right is vested in, or any duty is imposed upon, the Legislative Council, whether such power or right is to be exercised, or such duty is to be performed, by the Legislative Council in consequence of a resolution thereof or otherwise or by any members thereof, such power or right is hereby vested in, and such duty is hereby imposed upon, the Governor and shall be exercised or performed by him as nearly as circumstances may permit in the same manner as they would have been exercised or performed by the Legislative Council or any members thereof, and when so exercised or performed shall be deemed to have full legal validity and effect. Powers, rights or duties of Legislative Council to vest in, and to be exercised or performed by, Governor.
