BE it enacted:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Nicosia Water Supply (Arab Ahmet and Silikdar Vakfs) Management (Amendment) Law, 1933, and shall be read as one with the Nicosia Water Supply (Arab Ahmet and Silikdar Vakfs) Management Law, 1919, (hereinafter called "the Principal Law"), and the Principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Nicosia Water Supply (Arab Ahmet and Silikdar Vakfs) Management Laws, 1919 and 1933. Short title.

2. The Principal Law is hereby amended by the insertion immediately after section 17 of the following section:— Insertion
of new
section 17A
in Law 22
of 1919.

"Borrowing
powers.

17A.—(1) The Water Commission may, with the consent and under the authority of an Order of the Governor in Council and subject to such terms and conditions as may be imposed by such Order, borrow moneys for any of the purposes of this Law and may secure the repayment of the principal and interest by mortgaging any rate, rent, immovable property or waterworks or any part thereof.

(2) Notwithstanding anything contained in any other enactment the Governor may authorize the Delegates of Evcaf to guarantee any moneys borrowed by the Water Commission under this section and every such guarantee shall be a charge on the revenue of the Evcaf Department."

This Law came into operation on 16th June, 1933.

A LAW TO AMEND THE OATHS AND AFFIDAVITS LAW, 1931.

BE it enacted:—

Short title.
2 of 1931.

1. This Law may be cited as the Oaths and Affidavits (Amendment) Law, 1933, and shall be read as one with the Oaths and Affidavits Law, 1931, (hereinafter called "the Principal Law"), and the Principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Oaths and Affidavits Laws, 1931 and 1933.

2. Section 2 of the Principal Law is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following sub-section, the first part thereof being numbered accordingly:—

"Affidavit
for service of
criminal
summons.

(2) Whenever under the provisions of any other Law or enactment service of a criminal summons may be proved before any Court by affidavit sworn by the person who shall have effected the service, such affidavit may be taken, made and sworn before any Mukhtar who has been specially authorized by the Governor to administer oaths in that behalf."

This Law came into operation on 30th June, 1933.
