BE it enacted:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Village Roads (Amendment) Law, 1933, and shall be read as one with the Village Roads Laws, 1900 to 1931, (hereinafter called “the Principal Law”), and the Principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Village Roads Laws, 1900 to 1933.

2. Section 25 of the Principal Law is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following proviso at the end thereof:—

Amendment of section 25 of Law 6 of 1900.

“Provided that the Governor may, in any case or class of cases when in his judgment the circumstances require it,—

- (a) order the postponement of the execution of any Court warrant issued under the said Law either indefinitely or until such time as he may determine, or
- (b) direct that the whole or any part of the sum ordered to be paid under any such Court warrant shall not be collected or recovered, or
- (c) remit the whole or any part of the term of imprisonment in any such Court warrant prescribed.”

This Law came into operation on 9th August, 1933.
