A LAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE CHANGE OF OFFICIAL  
AND DEPARTMENTAL TITLES APPEARING IN  
ENACTMENTS.

BE it enacted :—

1. This Law may be cited as the Change of Titles Law, Short title.  
1934.

2. In this Law, unless the context otherwise requires,— Interpreta-  
tion.  
“enactment” means any Law or Order of His Majesty in Council, and includes any Order in Council, Order, Proclamation, Rule, Regulation, Commission, Bye-law or Notice made or issued under any Law or Order of His Majesty in Council.

3. The title of the public officer set out in the second column of the First Schedule hereto shall be substituted for the corresponding title set out in the first column of that Schedule wherever such title may appear in any enactment now in force in Cyprus or in any book or document whatsoever now in use in any Department of the Government of Cyprus. 4. Whenever any change of any title of any public officer is made at any future time, the Governor in Council may, by Order to be published in the *Cyprus Gazette*, make any necessary substitution in or addition to the First Schedule hereto, and the provisions of section 3 of this Law shall apply accordingly in conformity with every such substitution or addition as regards any enactment in force, and as regards any book or document whatsoever in use in any Department of the Government of Cyprus, at the date of the publication of such Order. 5. The departmental title set out in the second column of the Second Schedule hereto shall be substituted for the corresponding title set out in the first column of that Schedule wherever such title may appear in any enactment now in force in Cyprus or in any book or document now in use in any Department of the Government of Cyprus. 6. Whenever any change of the title of any Department, or of any branch of any Department, of the Government of Cyprus is made at any future time, the Governor in Council may, by Order to be published in the *Cyprus Gazette*, make any necessary substitution in or addition to the Second Schedule hereto, and the provisions of section 5 of this Law shall apply accordingly in conformity with every such substitution or addition as regards any enactment in force, and as regards any book or document whatsoever in use in any Department of the Government of Cyprus, at the date of the publication of such Order.
