BE it enacted:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Flour (Duties of Customs Variation) Law, 1935. Short title.

2. In this Law—

“flour” means wheaten flour and includes semolina and crushed or ground wheat.

Interpreta-
tion.

3.—(1) Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in any other enactment contained, the Governor in Council may from time to time by Order increase or reduce the duties of Customs leviable and recoverable on flour imported into Cyprus under the provisions of any enactment.

Powers of
Governor to
increase or

(2) Whenever an Order has been made under the provisions of this section, the duties of Customs on flour as increased or reduced thereby shall, from and after the date of the Order, be leviable and recoverable in accordance with the provisions of the enactment in force relating to the imposition and recovery of such duties.

(3) The Governor in Council may at any time alter or revoke in like manner any Order made hereunder.

(4) Every Order, and every alteration or revocation thereof, made hereunder shall, as soon as may be thereafter, be published in the *Cyprus Gazette*.

This Law came into operation on 1st July, 1935.
