BE it enacted:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Village Authorities (Amendment No. 2) Law, 1935, and shall be read as one with the Village Authorities Laws, 1931 to 1935, (hereinafter called “the Principal Law”), and the Principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Village Authorities Laws, 1931 to (No. 2) 1935.

Amendment
of section 5
of Law 19
of 1931.

2. Section 5 of the Principal Law is hereby amended as follows:—

(a) By the deletion of the words “between the ages of twenty-five and sixty years not being,” and the substitution therefor of the words “over twenty-five years of age not being—”.

(b) By the insertion at the end thereof of the following proviso:—

“Provided that no person who is over sixty years of age shall be liable to serve as Mukhtar or Aza except with his consent.”

This Law came into operation on 29th November, 1935.
