A LAW TO AMEND THE LAW RELATING TO CUSTOMS.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows:—

1. This Law may be cited as the Customs (Amendment) Law, 1940, and shall be read as one with the Customs Laws, 1936 to (No. 2) 1938, (hereinafter called "the Principal Law"), and the Principal Law and this Law may together be cited as the Customs Laws, 1936 to 1940. Short title.

Preamble.

WHEREAS it is necessary to make provision for such expenses of the Government of Cyprus for the year ending the thirty-first day of December, 1940, as are not already lawfully provided for or shall not hereafter be provided for by any Law.

BE it enacted by His Excellency the Governor and Commander-in-Chief of the Colony of Cyprus as follows:—

Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Appropriation Law, 1940.
