Short title.

1. This Law may be cited as the Imperial Defence (Cyprus Contribution) Law.

2. The sum of ten thousand pounds shall be paid yearly to the Imperial Government as the contribution of the Colony of Cyprus toward the cost of Imperial defence, and such sum shall be permanently charged on the consolidated revenue of the Colony.
