Interpretation.

- 2. (1) In this Law, unless the context otherwise requires— "Department" means the Department of Commerce and Industry;
 - "Director" means the Director of Commerce and Industry to the Government.
- (2) In all Laws and public instruments, enacted, made, issued, kept or in use, after the commencement of this Law, the expression "Director of Commerce and Industry" shall mean the Director of Commerce and Industry to the Government.

- 3. Notwithstanding anything in any Law, public instrudeemed to be ment, public notice or other document to the contrary references to contained—
